Solar Eclipse Information

This week we are looking forward to the **solar eclipse** on Monday, August 21, at 1:00 p.m. and **Hillside Curriculum Night** on Tuesday, August 22, from 6:00-7:30 p.m.

The solar eclipse will be active from about 11:30 until about 2:30 p.m. or so. Students who have a signed consent form on file with the district will go out with their teacher (and any parents who would like to come and help us to monitor correct use of eclipse glasses). The district has supplied us with solar eclipse glasses to protect eyes. I would ask that all students wear or bring a hat with a brim on Monday to add some shade to eyes as we go outside. A hat will offer further protection for eyes.



Students who will not be viewing the eclipse will be indoors in the gymnasium. We anticipate accessing a livestream of the eclipse event so those students may experience it in this way. As a precaution, we will be having indoor recess on that day for most grades (kindergarten may take an early break well before the solar event gets going).
